Jesus came to bring life, and we thank God for the lives He has changed this past year. Hopeless people attempting suicide have been healed and introduced to Jesus; people suffering with AIDS have been treated and felt Jesus' love through the ministry of Tenwek Hospital; staff members and village ladies have grown through Bible studies in which we have been involved; needy families have received tangible evidence of God's love through a new home or a cow; some alcoholics, like Alice, have been freed from the hold of sin and become free in Jesus.

Alice began attending a Tabitha Bible study in her neighborhood this year and loved to study about Paul and his adventures in Acts. She was a regular at the study, but Sundays were for brewing the illegal local drink. One day she was arrested and put in jail for her activities. 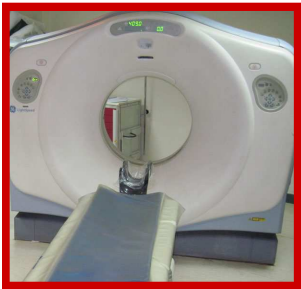

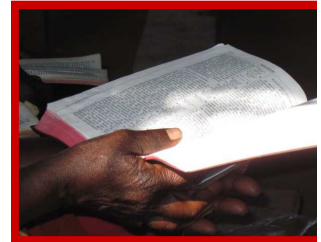
